HOW SHOULD I USE THIS LIST?

This list is a starting point; the numbers can only tell part of a school's story. Checking websites, visiting campuses, and speaking to parents, administrators, and teachers are still the best ways to ensure a good fit for your child.

WHY DON'T THESE SCHOOLS HAVE OREGON REPORT CARD GRADES?

Private schools are neither officially graded by the state nor held up to standardized performance metrics in the same way public schools are. However, private schools can voluntarily seek accreditation, during which an outside agency assesses the school's programs and curriculum against a uniform standard (see p. 40).

HOW COMPREHENSIVE IS THIS LIST?

Portland Monthly's research team scoured the Portland metro area and contacted more than 200 private schools, requesting detailed demographic information from each. While not every school responded to our survey, in the end we compiled a database of 103 private schools.

MY SCHOOL ISN'T ON THE LIST. WHY?

We covered only comprehensive private schools in Clark, Clackamas, Multnomah, and Washington Counties. Some schools were excluded because they receive public funds (so the state does not consider them private schools), such as most charter schools. We also omitted day cares, preschools, and kindergartens that did not also serve at least

one elementary grade, as well as single-subject schools and tutoring centers.

HOW DID YOU VERIFY THE DATA?

All of the information in this list is self-reported, and our research team double-checked everything with the schools themselves before we went to print.

ARE THE FIGURES HERE UP TO DATE?

The list reflects the 2009–2010 school year, the last complete year for which information is available.
